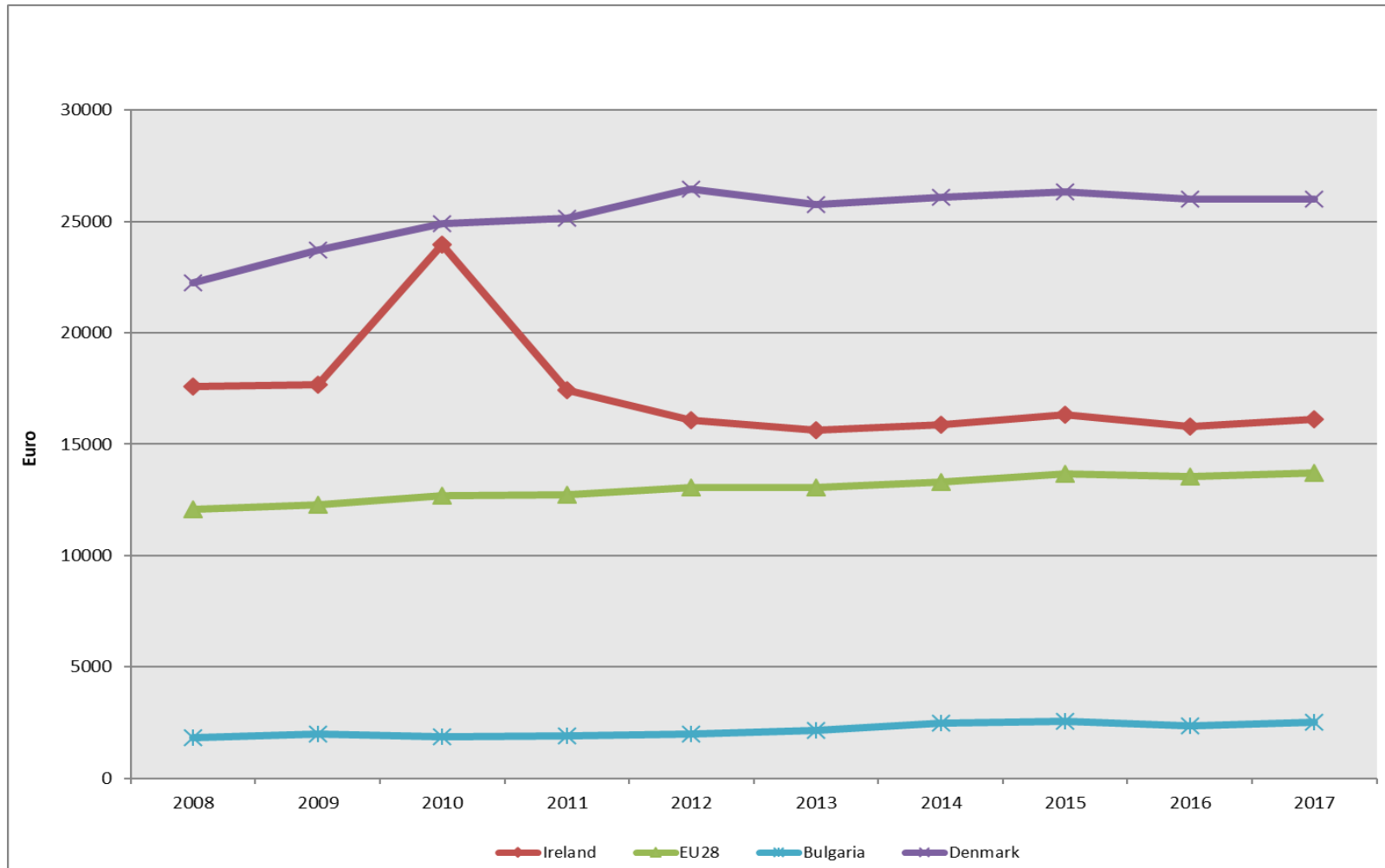

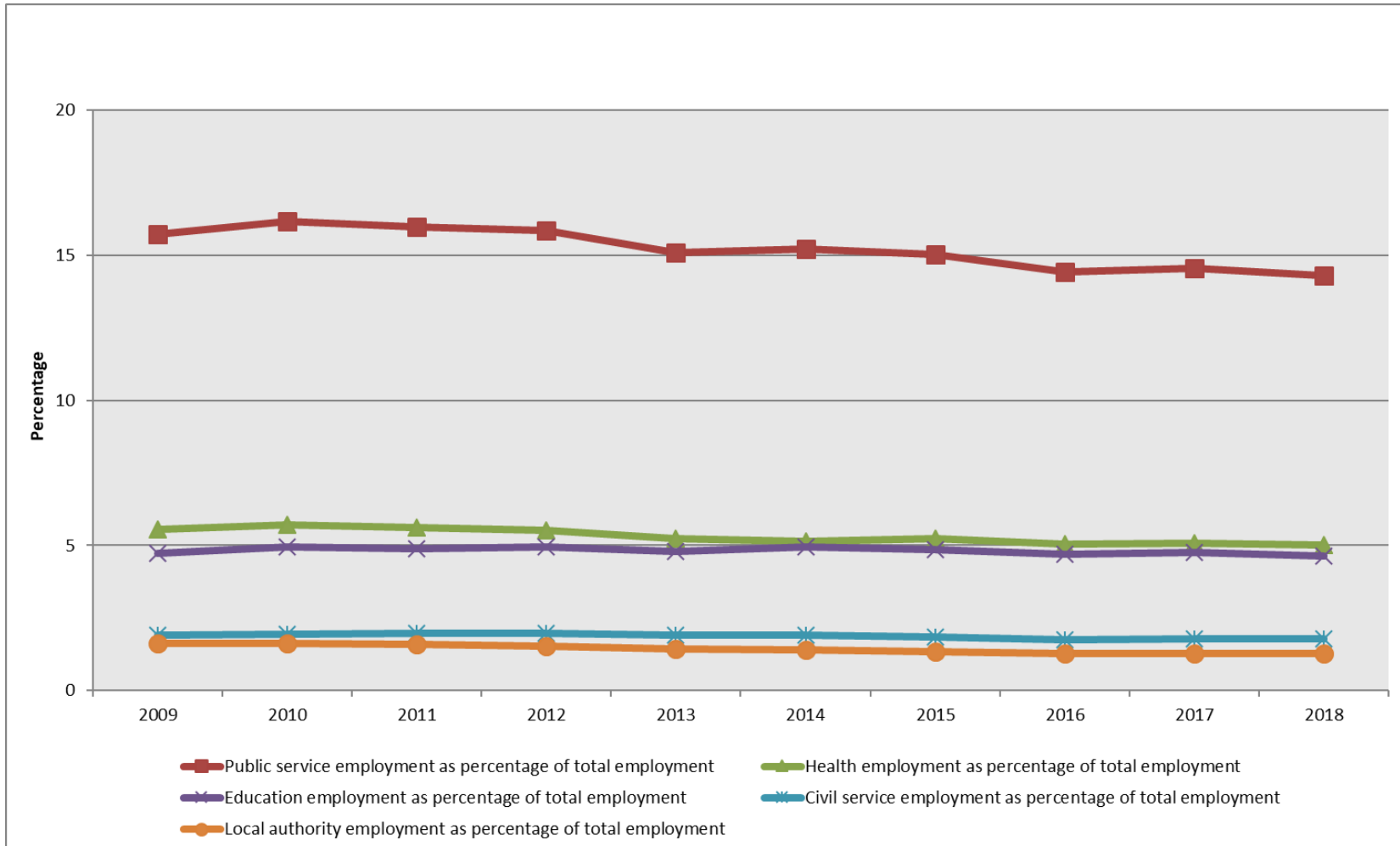

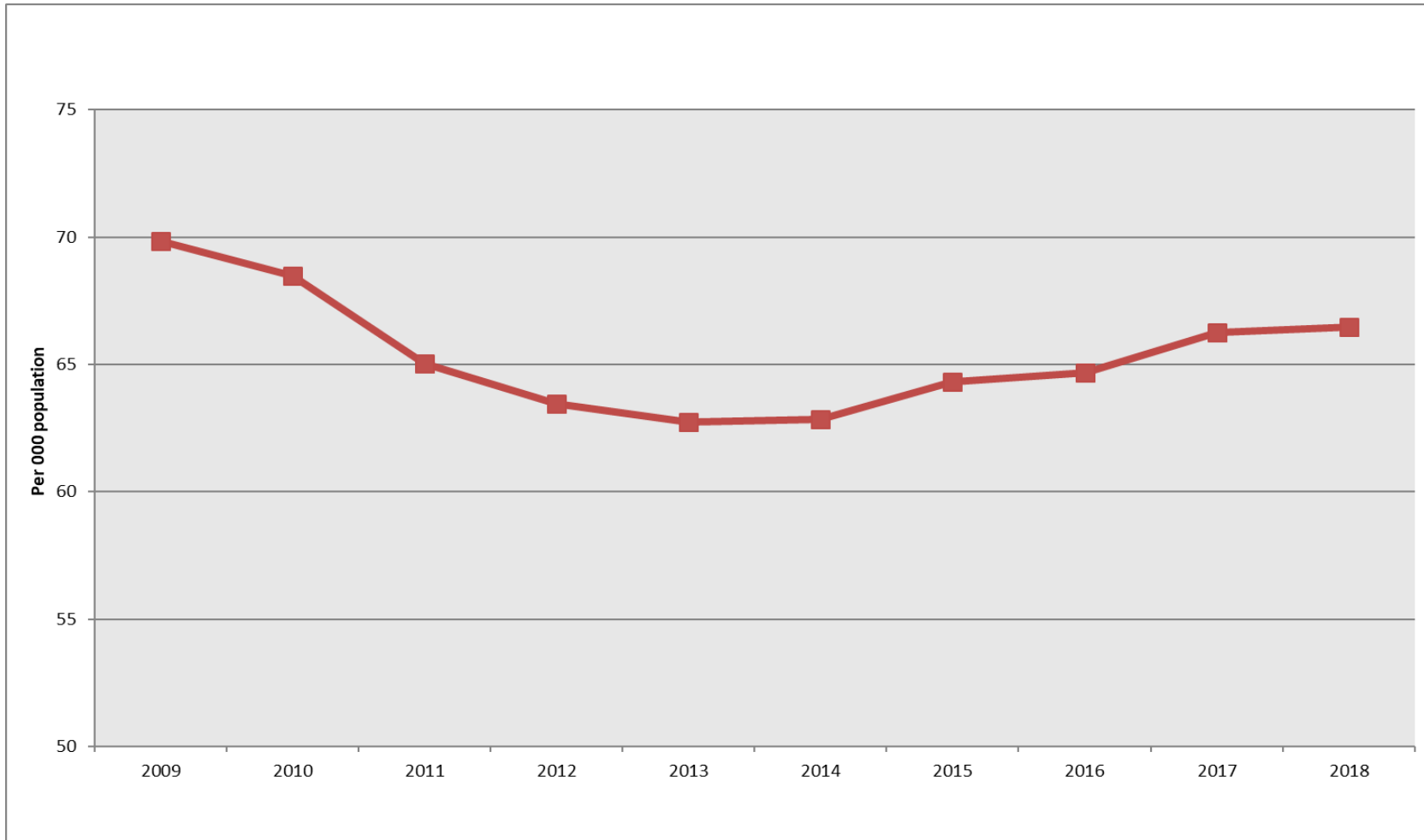
General government expenditure per head of population



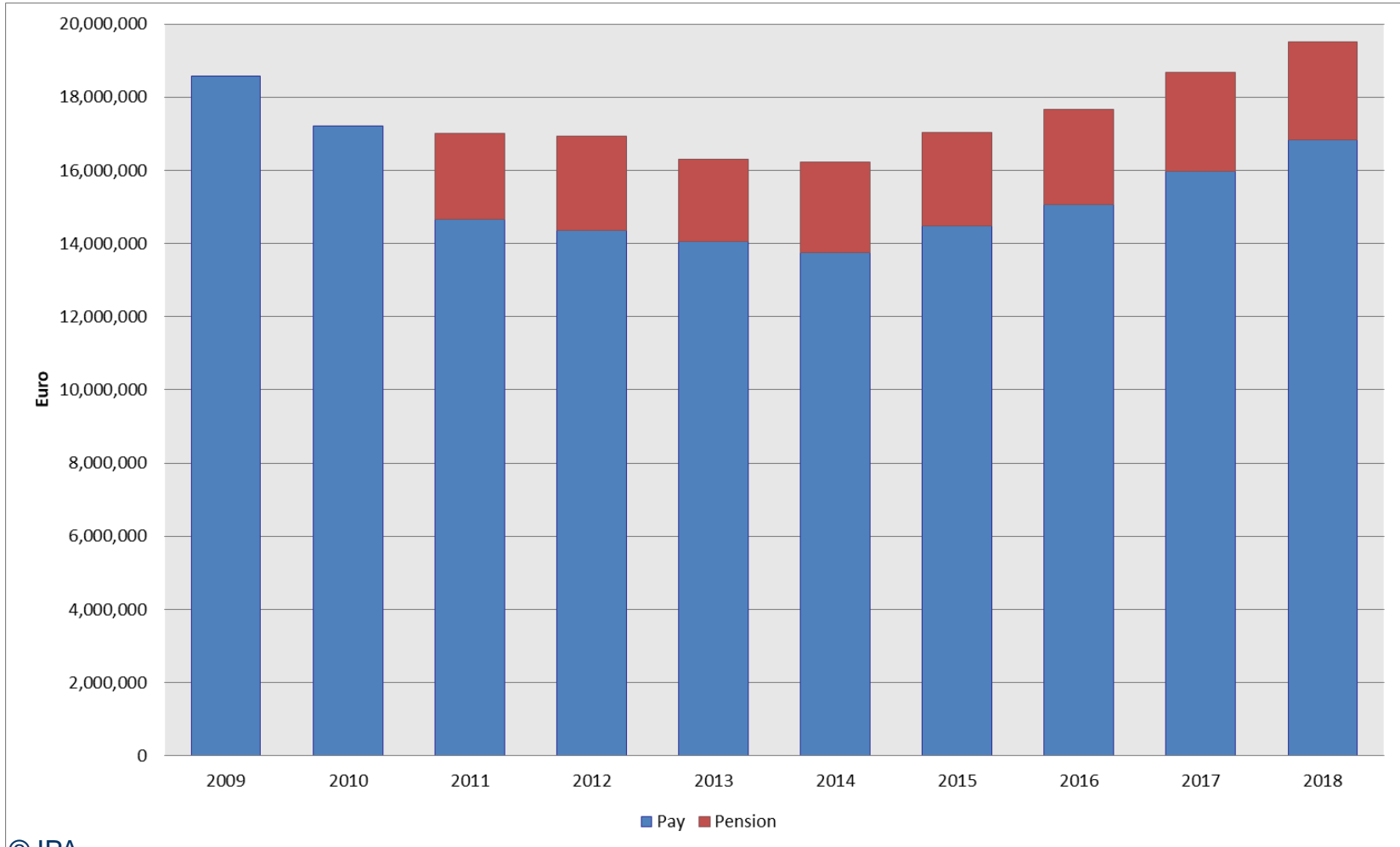
Public service employment as a percentage of all employment



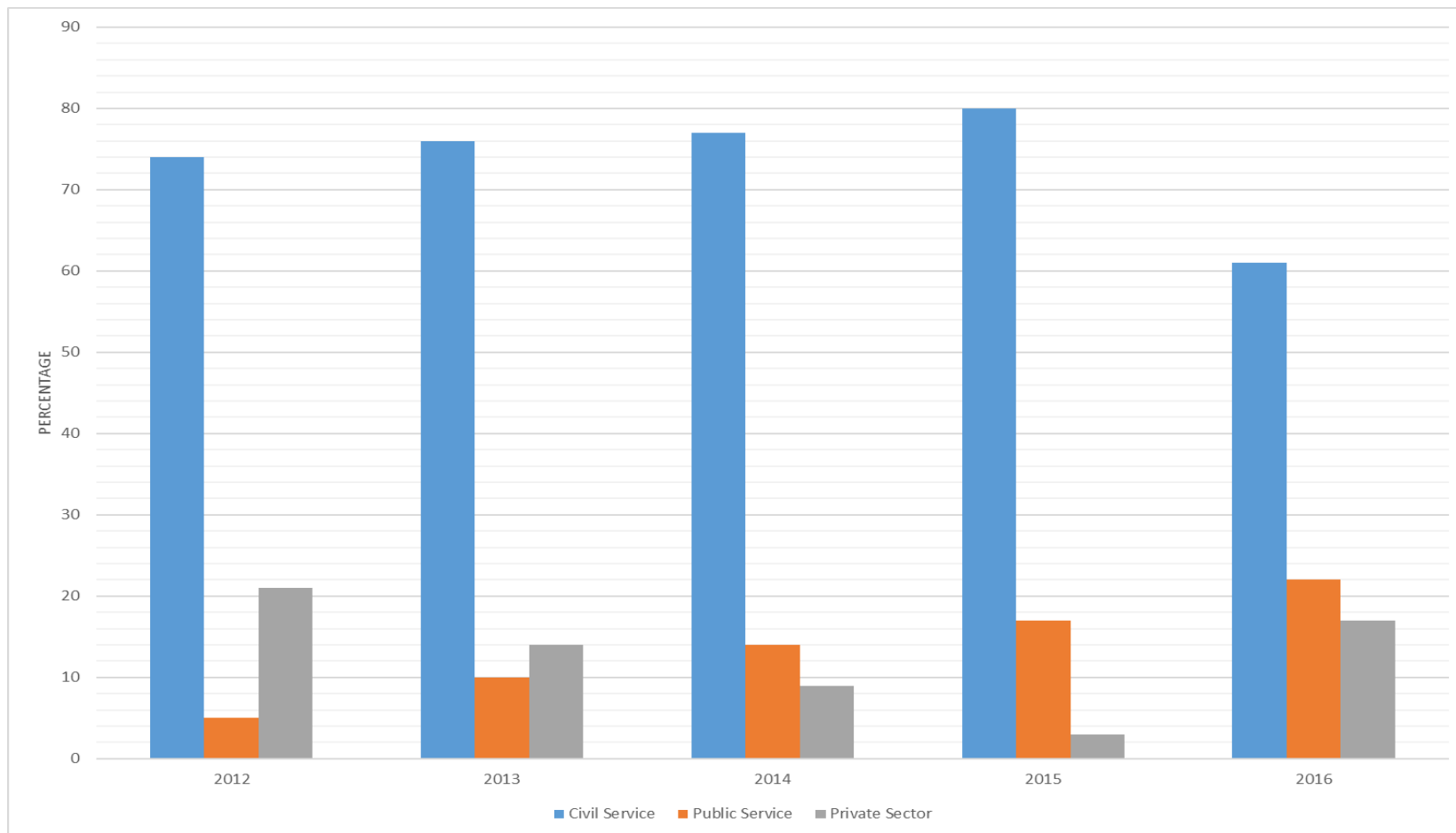
Public service employment per 000 population



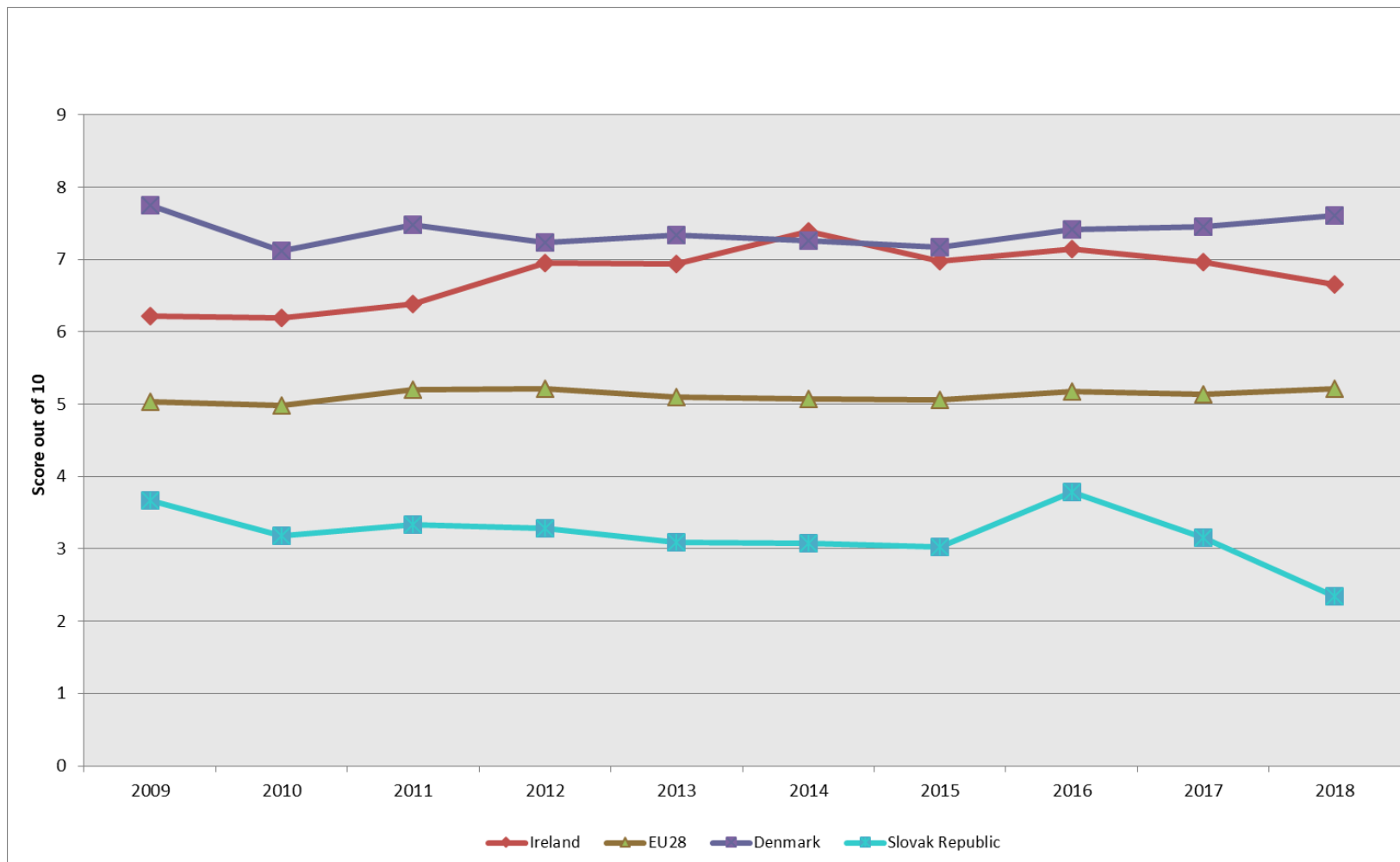
Public service pay and pensions



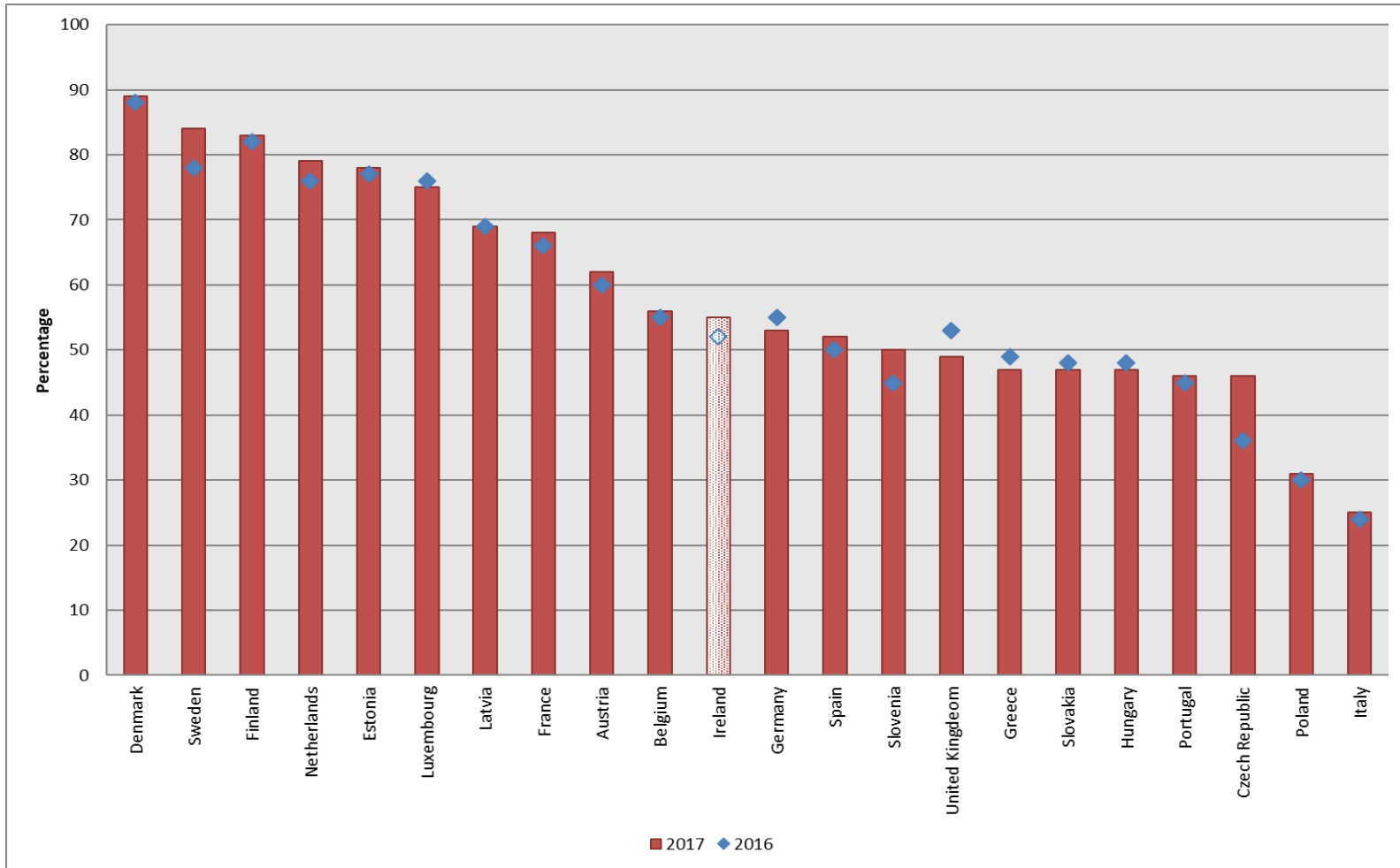

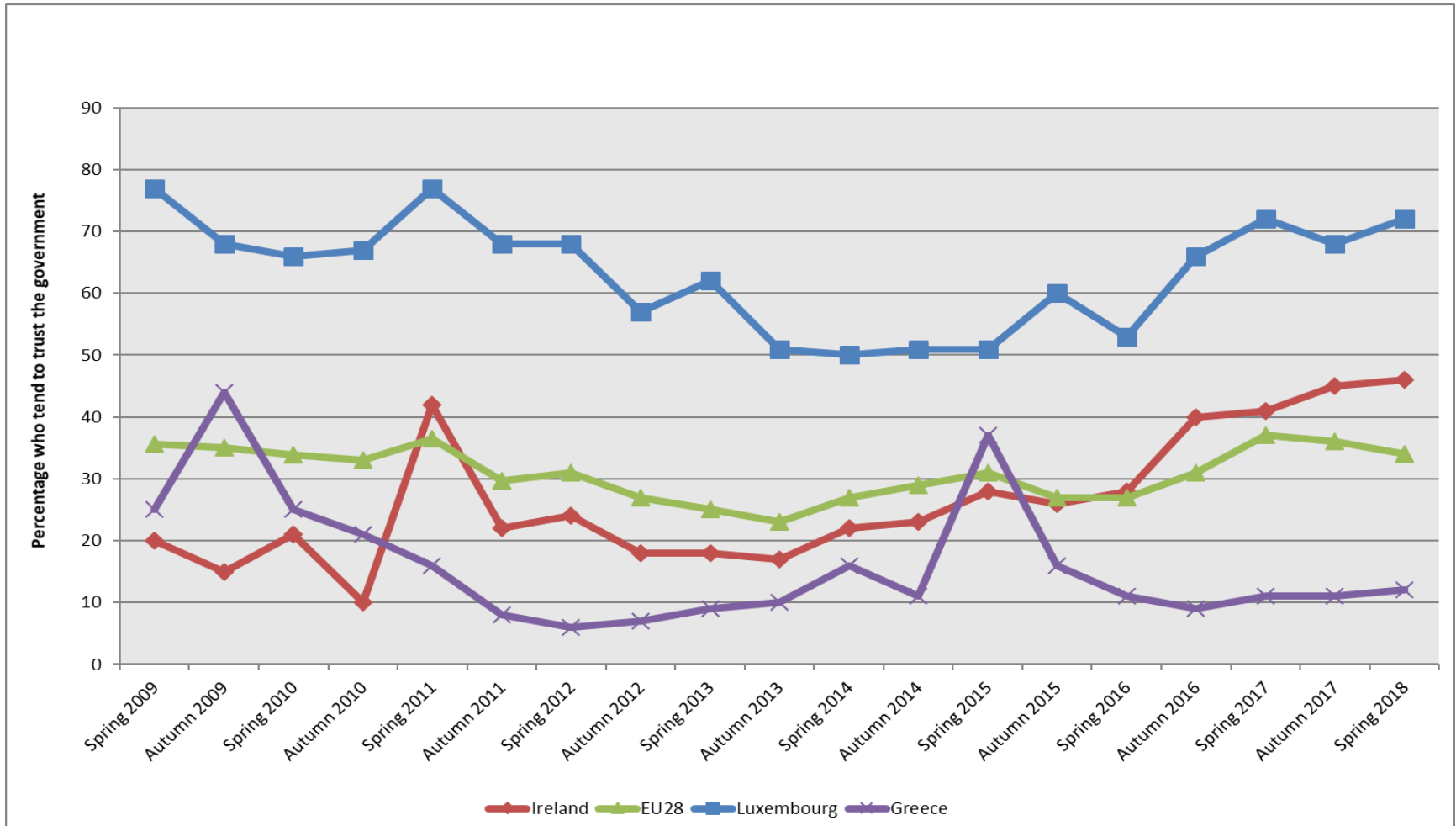
Quality of public administration



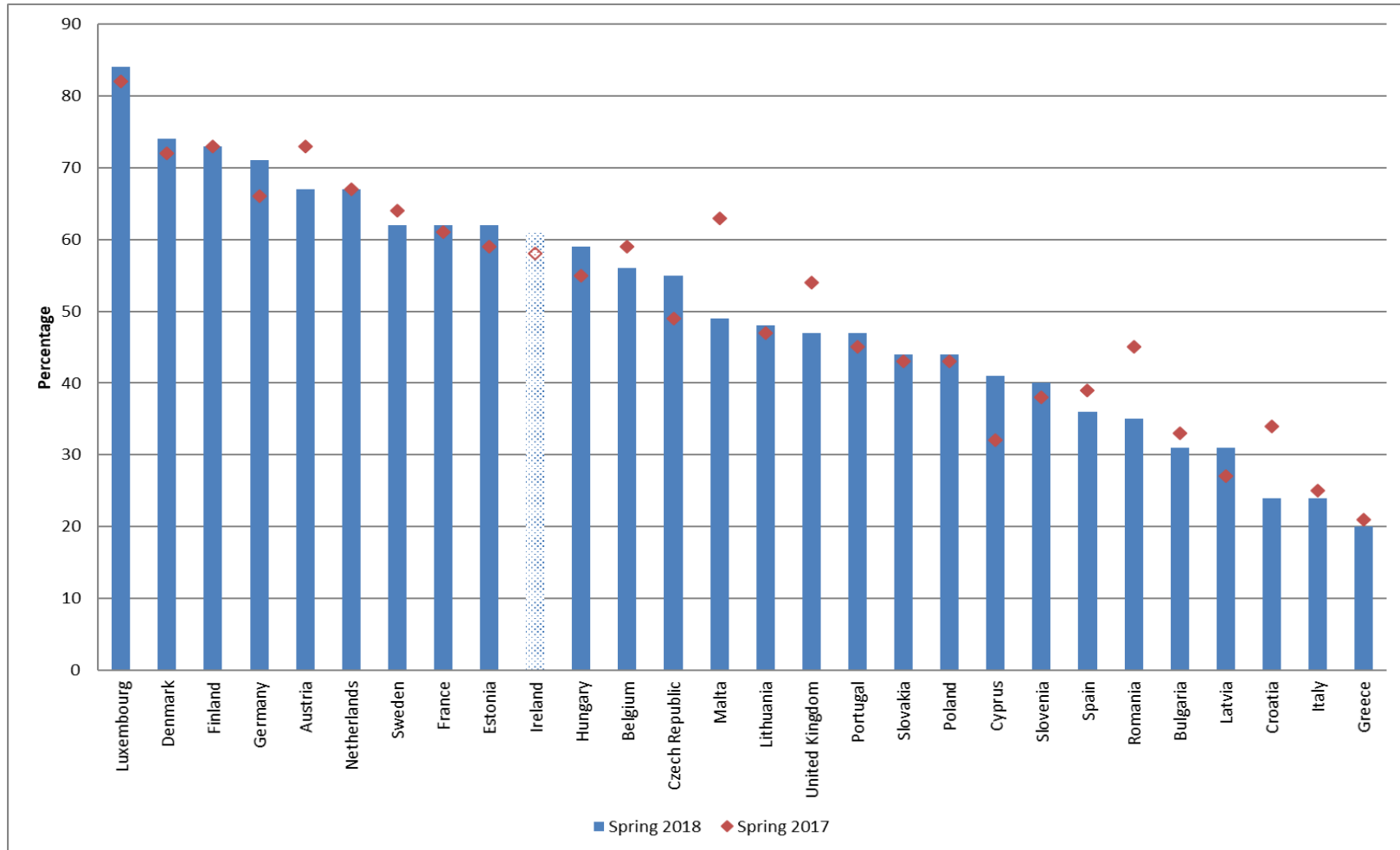
Individuals using the internet to obtain information about public bodies



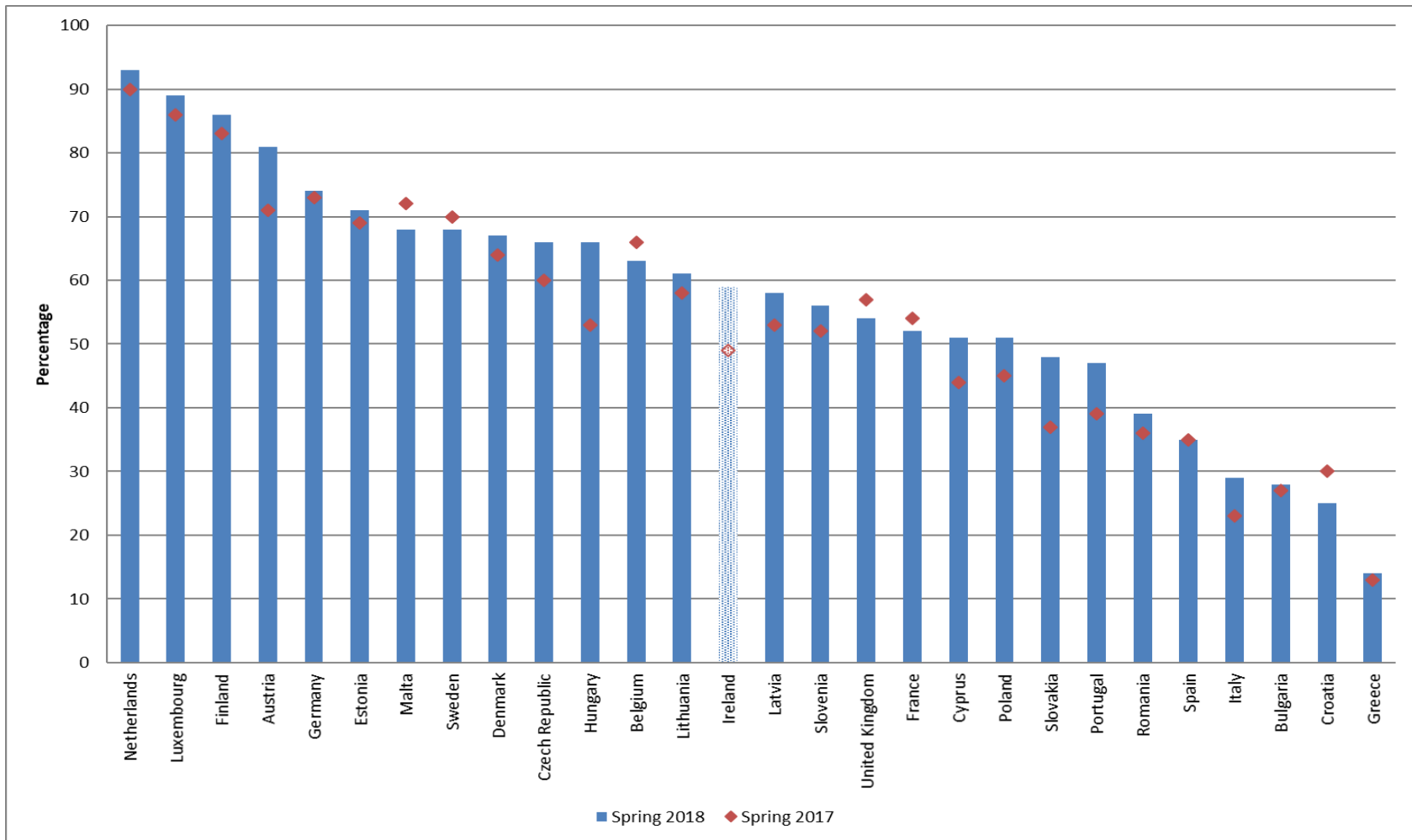
Level of trust in government
